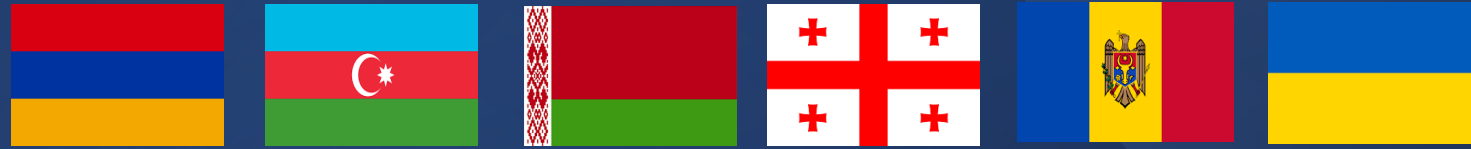

Council of European Energy Regulators (CEER)

- established in 2000
- represents 39 energy regulatory authorities (30 members, 9 observers)
- seeks to facilitate the creation of a single, competitive, efficient and sustainable EU internal energy market, acts as a platform for cooperation, information exchange and assistance



Energy Community (EnC)

- founded by the Treaty establishing the Energy Community signed in October 2005 in Athens, Greece, in force since July 2006
- 9 contracting parties, 3 observers
- establish a stable regulatory and market framework, create an integrated energy market, enhance the security of supply, improve the environmental situation in relation with energy supply and foster the use of renewable energy and energy efficiency and develop competition



International Energy Agency (IEA)

- created in 1974
- providing authoritative statistics and analysis and examining the full spectrum of energy issues
- advocating policies that will enhance the reliability, affordability and sustainability of energy in its 30 members countries and beyond

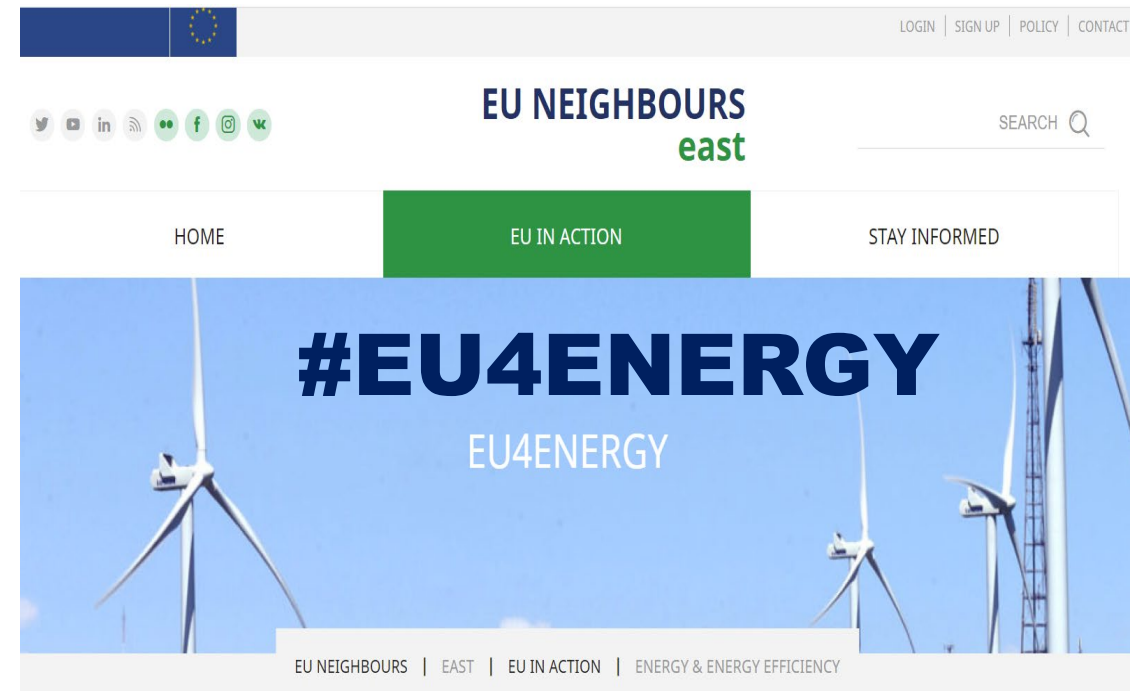
