ECRB Meeting

September 2021

M. Sc. E. E. Elton B. Radheshi Chairmain 7-th Working Group virtual meeting took place on May 11-th 2021

State of play;

AL: transposed REMIT as regulatory act.

BiH: already transposed.

KS*: transposed and ERO completed the format to be used for registration and plans to organise a workshop during this year.

ME: The law which transposes REMIT is consulted, but no progress yet.

MD: Government is working on Law amendments which include also REMIT provisions.

MK: Law transposing REMIT provision is drafted and consulted. ERC will need 3 months to make the necessary amendments to its regulatory acts after adaptation by the Parliament;

SR: The adopted Energy Law opens the door for transposition of REMIT as a regulatory act.

GE: A regulatory act which includes REMIT provisions, incorporated into energy market monitoring regulation is adopted.

UA: NEURC draft Law is in the process in the Parliament and two additional draft Laws have been registered with Parliament. The outcome is not clear.

TR: Some amendments on the legislation in gas sector in relation to monitoring the prices and sanction are being drafted.

The update will me made on the next meeting in October

Conclusions of the last meeting

TF 1: Regulatory Guidance on REMIT – leaded Alija Mujcinagic BiH & Marija Vujovic MN

The draft Guidance in the form of Q&A was presented and the document was submitted for comments which will be reviewed and the first version will be finalised. In order to improve continually the quality of the guidance, members are invited to record the questions asked by market participants regarding interpretation of certain provisions of REMIT and discuss them at ECRB REMIT WG.

The first edition will be finalised.

TF 2: Maintenance of central registry - leaded by Martin Martinoski - ERC

It was noted that there is not much space to improve the registration process therefore the WG agreed to proceed as discussed previously, national registries to be submitted to ECRB Section, which will then update the central registry. SERC Noted that it will consolidate the BiH REMIT register and submit to the ECRB Section being that they are in an later stage.

TF 3: Inside information platform - Sopio Khozrevanidze - Georgia

A draft questionnaire was presented which will be submitted to the members in establishment of Platforms for publication of inside information.

ECRB Section will submit the questionnaire for comments to the REMIT WG.

TF 4: Implementation of REMIT - Sinan Duyar – Turkish regulator & Arben Kllokoqi ECRB

ECRB Section presented a drat concept on how the activity on this TF will be performed. The draft questionnaire was presented and it was agreed that the questionnaire has already been submitted for consultation with WG members and then for completion.
